Definition of Allowed Training Courses and the Required Vetting Procedures

9 **BACKGROUND**

11 As of 2010, Quantico Shooting Club, Inc, (QSC) is the sole private organization chartered
12 with the responsibility of providing competitive matches for rifle, pistol and shotgun
13 involving civilian and military participants, recreational fire and marksmanship training
14 courses on board the Calvin A. Lloyd Range Complex. The efforts necessary to fulfill
15 these obligations under this charter accrue to the benefit of USMC and other Military
16 Families, civilian DOD employees, and a limited number of selected civilians. In prior
17 years, fulfillment of this charter was shared by numerous groups operating under
18 individual MOAs. Therefore, due to this added responsibility, QSC must develop a
19 structured and consistent definition of the type of marksmanship training that will be
20 allowed to be sponsored by the club, and a vetting procedure for the participants that is
21 both fair and thorough.

23 **PROPOSED RESOLUTION**

24

25 WHEREAS, the type of marksmanship training provided and sponsored by the club
26 cannot be construed as “tactical” in nature and,

28 WHEREAS, the marksmanship training sponsored by QSC must be provided on-board the
29 Calvin A. Lloyd Range complex and,

30

31 WHEREAS, the marksmanship training sponsored by QSC will be advertised as and
32 enacted in the spirit of improving marksmanship skills, providing greater insight as to
33 various match courses of fire, and safe weapons handling and,

35 WHEREAS, marksmanship training involving firing position movement and multiple
36 weapons firing (e.g., three-gun training), constantly variable firing lines (e.g., skeet and
37 American Trap training), and long range rifle skills improvement (e.g., wind deflection
38 and temperature gradient training), needs to be provided for the purpose of honing match
39 participation skills or recreational shooting experiences and,

41 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of QSC, and by extension, MCB Quantico, to be able to
42 offer marksmanship training to as many legitimate and qualified participants as possible
43 for the sole purpose of improving match participation or recreational shooting
44 experiences,

45

46 THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the QSC Board of Directors, and the Match
47 Executive Officer, must approve the curriculum of any rifle, pistol, or shotgun
48 marksmanship training sponsored by QSC,

49

50 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the marksmanship training sessions will be open to
51 club members, their guests, and other individuals who are legally eligible to own and/or
52 operate firearms onboard MCB Quantico and,

53

54 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the vetting process employed by the marksmanship
55 training course supervisor to screen prospective students who are not members of QSC, or
56 the guest of a member of QSC, shall follow the guidelines employed by the club to screen
57 prospective members. If the prospective participant can provide the following
58 documentation, they will be considered eligible to participate in QSC-sponsored
59 marksmanship training on-board MCB Quantico.

- 61 a. An active duty or retired military ID, including those provided by the Coast
62 Guard, Merchant Marines, Armed Forces Reserves or National Guard or,
63 b. A Department of Defense employee ID or,
64 c. A law-enforcement organization, Federal, State or local, employee ID or,
65 d. Documentation showing membership and participation in a Student ROTC
66 or Military Cadet program or,
67 e. A State issued Concealed Weapons Carry Permit or,
68 f. A Federal, State or Local government issued photo ID along with a valid
69 passport, alien resident ID or a Social Security Card.
