

# QSC LIVE FIRE BRIEF

The QSC RSO will have the following information ready when calling Range Control to go "HOT."

- (0) Provide RSO name and last four.
- (1) Provide the name of the QSC OIC and certify that he/she is on the WTBn Range Complex.
- (2) Certify that the EMT is present at QSC Clubhouse.
- (3) Certify that the Range Flag is posted.
- (4) Certify that the safety Vehicle is present at QSC Clubhouse.
- (5) Certify that you have identified left and right lateral limits per the Range Safety Card and that they are visible and valid at this time.

RSO read 1-7 below and verify that you understand and will comply.

- (1) The unit will man the radio at all times. Constant radio communication must be maintained with Range Control at all times. The unit will make radio checks every **30 minutes** (live fire) from your "HOT" time.
- (2) The unit will put itself into cease fire immediately if communication is lost. **Range Control may put the unit into cease fire if the unit fails to make radio checks.**
- (3) If a fire starts anywhere, the unit will contact Range Control immediately and await further instructions.
- (4) If there is a negligent discharge or a round is fired that is suspected to have impacted outside of the lateral limits of the range, the unit will immediately contact Range Control.
- (5) If any aircraft enters the unit's impact area, the unit will put itself in cease fire immediately and contact Range Control.
- (6) If the unit has a MEDEVAC, regardless of severity, the unit will immediately contact Range Control and await further instructions.
- (7) The unit will notify Range Control when ready to go into a "Cold" status.
