

who served in combat zones, who are not eligible to become regular members, and Retired DoD employees will be considered Associate Members.

- **Associate.** Any person (civilian) who is sponsored by a Club Member in good standing, or as approved by the Board of Directors, may join the Club as an Associate Member. The only restriction that applies is that the total number of the Associate Members cannot at any point in time equal more than 1/3 of the total Club Membership.
- **Membership Ratio.** Per our bylaws, our MOA, and MCBO 7010.1B, Quantico Shooting Club must maintain a ratio between the total number of all Club members to the total number of Regular Members. At no time can the ratio of Regular Members to the total Club Membership be less than two-thirds. The Operations Officer manages this ratio and will process associate membership applications when positions become available. If positions are unavailable, the Operations Officer will inform the applicant and add associate member applications to the waiting list based on the date and time of receipt.

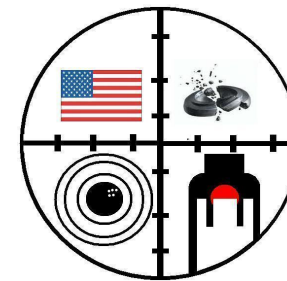

Who We Are

- **Quantico Shooting Club (QSC)** is a 501C-7 Not-for-Profit corporation operating as a Tenant organization on board Marine Corps Base Quantico (MCBQ), Quantico, Virginia . We are a private organization **NOT affiliated with the Federal Government**. We are not a part of the Department of Defense or any of its components and we **have NO government status**. However, since we are located on Department of the Navy Property, **Federal Government and Military rules, regulations and laws apply**.
- **The Basis** for our approved operation as a Tenant organization aboard MCBQ is a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between MCBQ and QSC. Due to our 501C-7 status all contributions to the club monetary or otherwise, including the annual Dues, are not tax-deductible.

Our Location

- **Quantico Shooting Club** is located aboard MCBQ west of Interstate 95 in Virginia, 36 miles south of Washington D.C. and 18 miles north of Fredericksburg.
- **From I-95, take Exit 148** and follow Russell Road (MCB 1) West. After traveling 3/4 of a mile you will pass through a military checkpoint. A valid, picture ID is required to enter Quantico Marine Corps Base.
- **Continue** through the check point approximately 3 miles and the Club House is on your right across from the Quad Maintenance Facility.

What We Offer

QSC offers several different marksmanship and recreational disciplines for the shooting enthusiast. If you are a new shooter, we can assist you with instruction on the fundamentals. For the more experienced marksman, our club hosts rifle, pistol, and shotgun competitions and advanced

marksmanship training. Like our Marine hosts, we are committed to Range Safety, marksmanship and excellence. Certain ammunition restrictions apply. See our website for detailed information.

Range Safety

At Quantico Shooting Club, Range Safety is our first concern. To that end, your safety is protected by our members who are qualified Officers in Charge (OICs) and Range Safety Officers (RSOs), certified by the Marine Corps and through a special training course provided by QSC. Whenever QSC has the Calvin A. Lloyd Complex Ranges “Hot,” EMT personnel and emergency transportation are provided in addition to QSC RSOs and OICs . Remember:

- Keep your weapon unloaded and in a safe condition until ready to engage the target,
- Always point your weapon in a safe direction,
- Never point your weapon at something you don't intend to shoot,
- Always keep your finger straight and off of the trigger until ready to fire.

Recreational Fire

- **Rifle** We have access to a 7 to 300 yard multipurpose range (Range 1), two - 200 to 600 yard ranges (Ranges 2 and 3), and the only **200 to 1000-yard rifle** range within several hundred miles (Range 4).
- **Pistol** We have available two 25 yard ranges (Comp and Requal) and one 7 yard plus range (Range 1)
- **Shotgun** We offer International Trap, International and American Skeet and American (Wobble) Trap, all located within walking distance of the clubhouse.

Competition

- **Rifle** Across the Course Matches, long range disciplines including Full Bore, Palma, High Power, and F-Class matches are offered by QSC
- **Pistol** Several major classifications for

competitive pistol shooting. These include conventional (bull's eye) pistol, International-style pistol, and action pistol.

- **Shotgun** QSC offers four types of Shotgun Sport Shooting experiences: International (Bunker) Trap, American (Wobble) Trap, American Skeet and International Skeet. Our International Trap Range is one of the few covered ranges in the United States.

Training

QSC is not just a gun club and is far more than just a place to shoot. Our Club was formed to promote marksmanship and disseminate small arms firing techniques and marksmanship training methods. Like the Marine Corps, we take marksmanship very seriously and host some of the Nation's best instructors for your benefit. From the beginner to the expert marksman, Quantico Shooting Club is a place to bolster your skills.

Membership

Eligibility

Quantico Shooting Club, Inc. is a private organization aboard MCBQ, and as such the conduct of its business is governed by the QSC bylaws, the MOA between the Club and MCBQ, and MCBO 7010.1B. In that vein, the QSC Board of Directors may approve QSC membership for **U.S. Citizens**, who are legally eligible to possess or use firearms individually or with adult supervision, and who reside within a **60 mile radius of MCBQ**. QSC can recognize membership in the following categories

- **Regular Member**. Any member of the Marine Corps or other Armed Forces, Active Duty, Reserve or Retired, or any DoD employee is qualified to be a Regular Member. In addition, the Club encourages family memberships, at no additional cost, for any dependent family member of any Regular Member. Former POWs, Purple Heart recipients, and veterans
